Whether your interest is myths and legends, sacred art, writing or performing, or even your own quest through life, there is something for anyone and everyone fascinated with the mystery of the Grail legend. **Ink Pot Arts**, in collaboration with **Painted Space**, is launching **The Parsifal Project** June 2022! This multimedia year-long community project is a contemporary envisioning of the famous medieval legend, one that aims to reframe the Parsifal legend for a modern multicultural audience – then stage it in 2023. *This is a unique opportunity to take part in the development of this multifaceted process.*

“Most societies have come to define themselves by their historical myths and national narratives. We are, who we say we are... people grow up believing they live within a story ... what is the story we believe we are living within? Where is our narrative going?” Prof. David Blight, 2009

What are the myths and legends we live by? Why do the Grail and Arthur legends speak to us today? And who was Parsifal and his sister Dindrane? What might they represent for us in modern, multicultural Australia today? Immerse yourself in this rich exploration of the Parsifal legend. Using drama and image, we will introduce you to this sacred story through snapshot performances from the definitive literary texts, artworks and modern film.
